

MALARIA OUTREACH IN KASOKOSO NAKAWA.

On 4th march 2021 A team of scouts moved to Kasokoso Slum to carry out the SAM Campaign.

Covid is real and so they had to observe the SOPs but also sensitise communities about Covid 19 pandemic

300 nets were distributed to that community

Challenges.

Many people had given up on the fight against malaria and had concentrated on Covid 19

There are so many teenage mothers in the community who have no idea that Malaria still claims lives especially expectant mothers.

They don't know that they can lose their babies in case they get malaria.

We therefore gave them net and advised them to sleep under mosquito nets but also attend antenatal care every month in order to be examined by a medical doctor.

It is important to note that the need for community sensitisation has risen because of the expectant child mothers.

Since Kasokoso is a slum, more emphasis was put on draining all stagnant water and keeping the grass around the homes slashed.
