During the pandemic We reached to kasokoso village. Covid is real and so we had to observe the SOPs .We also sensitise communities about Covid 19 and Malaria.

Our observations are:

-There are so many teenage mothers in the community who have no idea that Malaria still claims lives especially expectant mothers. They don't know that they can lose their babies in case they get malaria.



The need for sensitisation is great because in the homes we entered we had to tie up the nets as a way of training the mothers and their children how to sleep under a net.



Education is key as we give out these nets.

There is a lot of congestion in this slum and the population is so big. It is important to also talk about hygiene around the homes

for example, draining all stagnant water and slashing the bushes around homes.

It is important for the mothers to know that when they suspect malaria, they should seek medical care instead of self-prescription.
