- Shows signs of being reliable and willing to commit to a long-term project
- Understands the expectations of preparation, fundraising, and participation

SELECTION WEEKEND

How do we all behave?

There's a Code of Conduct:

Scouts, Explorers and Young Leaders should:

- show respect to fellow Scouts, Scout Leaders, and other members of the Scout Association.
- be respectful and tolerant of each other at all times.
- Not use mobile devices during the activity unless explicitly authorised.
- Not bring offensive weapons, such as knives, to this activity
- Not bring any illegal substances (drugs, cigarettes, alcohol) to this activity
- use appropriate language and refrain from swearing.
- Ask the leader team if they are unsure about any aspect of the activity
- These guidelines are designed to create a safe and enjoyable environment for all
 participants in Scouting activities. Scouts, Explorers and Young Leaders are
 encouraged to follow these rules to maintain the integrity and spirit of the scouting
 community.

What to bring:

- Personal tent, pegs and mallet
- Sleeping bag and roll mat
- Camp chair
- Personal clothing for weekend (suitable for weather conditions)
- Suitable outdoor footwear
- Plate, bowl, mug, cutlery and tea towel
- Wash kit/towel
- Daysack
- Drinks bottle
- Quiet game (not electronic)
- Torch
- Unit/Group scarf (uniform is not required)

- Uniform
- Items that breach the code of conduct

What happens after the weekend?

- The leader team will meet after you have left and recommend those who are suitable for the World Scout Jamboree.
- From those who are suitable, we will identify the best 72 participants.
- We will email the 72 successful participants within 7- 10 days and ask them to commit to the World Scout Jamboree.
- We will write to all other participants to tell them:
 - They have been identified as a possible reserve
 - They may be invited to an alternative international experience
 - The World Scout Jamboree is not for them


